Lydia's artistic training includes art courses taken by correspondence (Paris, France), art courses at the University of Manitoba, advertising and modelling at the Art Symposium in Winnipeg, commercial art at Bauder College, Florida, USA, art and relief printing at the Ottawa School of Art and art restoration.

Through diverse media workshops and classes, Lydia has been influenced to develop and apply a very wide range of techniques in her works, whether they be paintings or sculptures. She uses charcoals, inks, pastel, airbrush and mixed media and has perfected a distinctive hand pulled print technique evolving sometimes into a three dimensional art form.

Lydia's works are exhibited in various galleries in Canada, the USA and overseas where quite a number of them, sculptures, paintings and prints, can be found in private collections.

Lydia is an active member of several art groups including the Ottawa Art Association, the Network of Sculptors and the OMMA (Ottawa Mixed Media Association).
